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Next Week

Reading— In reading next week our concept is learning to succeed. We will be reading to answer the essential questions, "Why are goals important?". The students will build academic vocabulary with the words: essential, communicated, goal, motivated, professional, research, serious, and specialist. Our foundational reading skills are vowel team syllables and greek and latin root words.

<u>Writing</u>- Next week in grammar I will introduce adverbs that tell how. We will also review adverbs and adjectives. Adverbs and adjectives will be connected our writing. These types of words help us describe nouns and verbs. In writing, the students will also continue to practice writing in their three genres: informational, narrative, and opinion.

<u>Math</u>— We are on our final math chapter, Interpreting and Analyzing Data. The students will also be taking their final math assessments. They will be doing the aimsweb computation and concepts and applications skills test. They will also need to complete their final benchmark test that assesses all chapters covered in 3rd grade.

<u>Science</u>— We will begin our unit called, "Power of Flowers". This unit focuses on plant life cycles and heredity.

<u>Social Studies</u>— We will begin chapter S, "Michigan Grows Up". The students will learn how the soil in Michigan helped it grow as a state.
